Based on early cautions, many clinicians limit EMDR therapy to only highly-functioning dissociative clients who have undergone a long preparation phase that depends upon other modalities. From this conceptualization, the use of EMDR is erroneously limited, depriving many survivors of severe


traumatization the benefits of EMDR therapy.

Clinical case examples and video fragments will illustrate interventions with EMDR for dissociative clients following the **"Progressive Approach"** (Gonzalez & Mosquera, 2012).

This workshop will demonstrate how EMDR clinicians can safely utilize a wide range of EMDR interventions throughout treatment for patients with dissociative disorders. Our aim is to provide a comprehensive model for applying EMDR therapy in the treatment of dissociative disorders. EMDR therapists will learn to integrate new interventions into their clinical work at different phases of treatment. In particular, they will learn to implement specific clinical interventions, based on 'progressive protocols' for Complex Traumatization and Dissociative Disorders.
